

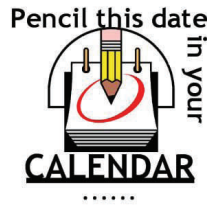

Prov. 4:1-4 - "Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and . . . let thine heart retain my words: Keep my commandments, and live." Children must honor their parents and be willing to receive instruction and correction.

Prov. 14:26-27 - "In the fear of the Lord is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge. The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death." Children who have a reverential fear of the Lord will find safety, security and protection against a life of ruin. Fearing the Lord assures longevity.

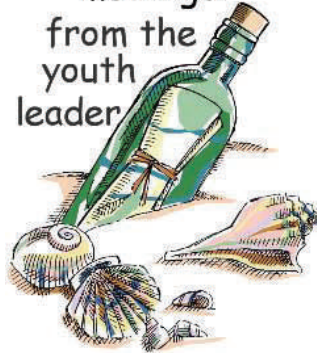
Synthesis of Wisdom's Way from Proverbs for this area:

Unity recently had all of the doors in the church replaced, rounding out a replacement of the outer and inner doors of the church.

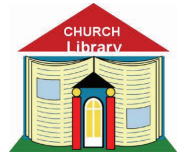


Around the Church
