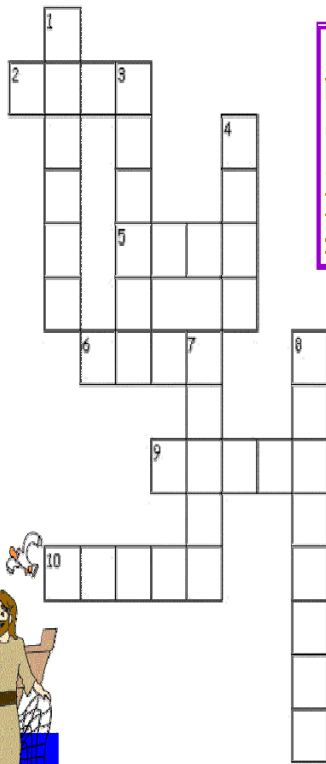

October has been set aside as Pastor Appreciation month, an opportunity for us to rally around our pastor and let him know how much we appreciate him:



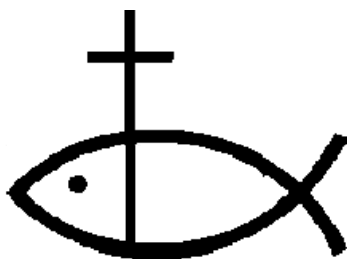
