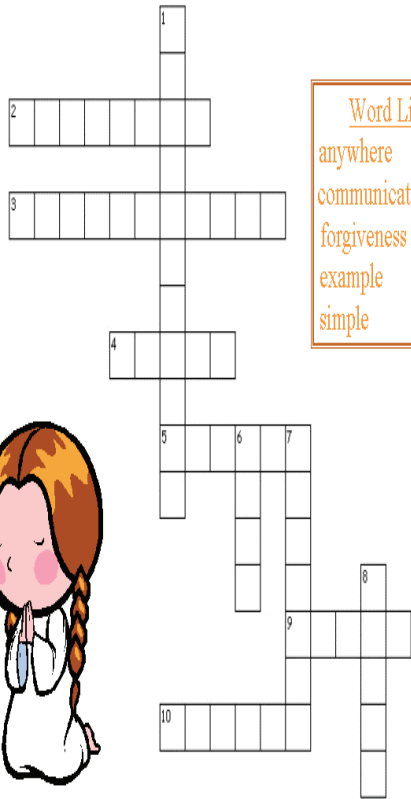

This complex cross, also called the Crusader's Cross or Fivefold Cross, has several

interpretations. The main cross is composed of four tau (T) crosses representing the Old Testament law. The four small Greek crosses symbolize the fulfillment of the law in the gospel.



The five crosses together represent the church's mission: to spread the gospel to the four corners of the earth. They're also said to symbolize Christ's five wounds (hands, feet and side). Godfrey de Bouillon, the first ruler of Jerusalem after it was liberated from the Muslims, used the cross on his coat-of-arms. It was also embodied in the heraldry of the Crusaders.

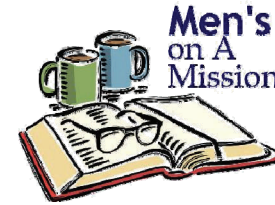
As Grandma approached the door, she was happy to pass through -- perhaps she passed through as she slept or maybe she took death by the hand and leaped over the threshold into eternal life.
